

Using Your Kindle with Jasmine Digital Library (OverDrive)

What you'll need:

- ♦ a Kindle (any generation)
- ♦ an Amazon.com account
- ♦ a computer with Internet access
- ♦ a web browser (Internet Explorer, Safari, etc)
- ♦ a valid Berkeley County Library card

What Kindle device do you have?

Find your serial number on the back of your device.

The beginning of the serial number = type of Kindle

B001 = Kindle 1

B002 = Kindle 2 US

B003 = Kindle 2 International

B004 = Kindle DX US

B005 = Kindle DX International

B006 = Kindle 3 wi-fi and 3G

B008 = Kindle 3 wi-fi only (regular and Special offers edition)

B009 = Kindle DX Graphite

B00A = Kindle 3 wi-fi and 3G for European customers

B00E = Kindle 4

***Kindles listed in RED : download library e-books to a laptop or pc and then transfer them to your Kindle via USB.**

***Kindles listed in BLUE can download library e-books via a wi-fi connection.**

The following steps take place in your computer's Web browser. It is possible but much more tedious to complete using the Kindle's built in Web browser.

Step 1. Check out your e-book.

To transfer to your Kindle via USB. Click on "Download now"

Download the Kindle-compatible book to your computer and add it to the Kindle through the USB cable (the cable that came with your Kindle).

Option B.) You can download your Kindle-compatible book to your computer and add it to the Kindle through the USB cable.

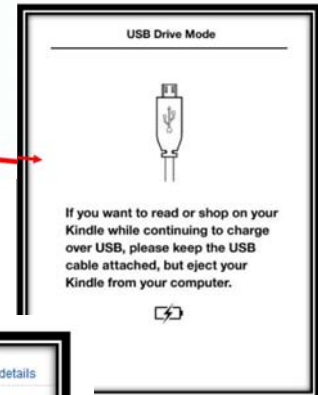


To transfer your content via USB, you will need to connect your Kindle to your computer with the USB cable that came with your Kindle. Note: Your computer must have a USB port.

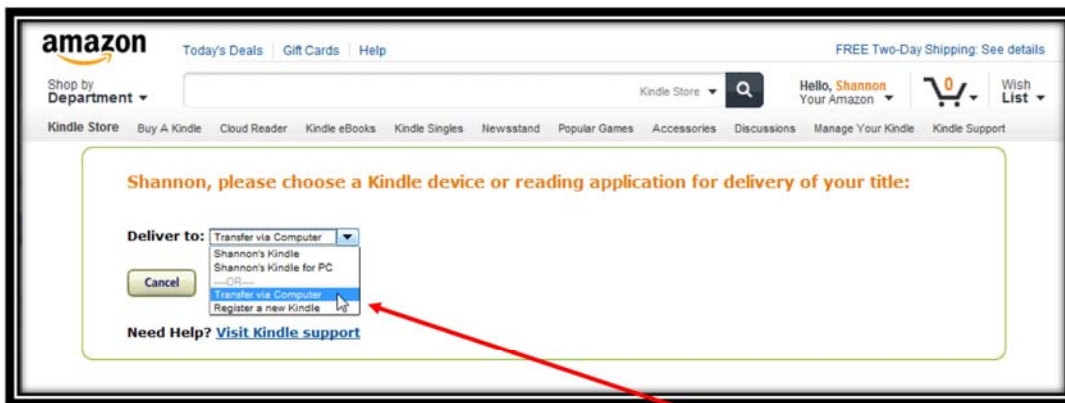


Once you've connected your Kindle via the USB cable, it should appear as a removable storage device (usually named 'Kindle'). You can locate the Kindle by opening the 'My Computer' icon in Windows-based computers.

NOTE: You can tell if you've successfully connected your Kindle to your computer if you see the following screen on the Kindle.



Now that you have your Kindle attached via USB, you may download your library e-book directly to the Kindle.



To transfer your content through the USB cable, select 'Transfer via Computer' from the drop down menu.

Next, specify which Kindle will be receiving the content and click the 'Continue' button. (This is just in case you have more than one Kindle associated with your Amazon.com account).

When file download window pops up, **SAVE** file. If you get a pop-up window asking you where you want to save it, choose the Kindle drive to get the book in one step.

To return your e-book early, go to www.amazon.com.

On the left side of the webpage, under **"Shop All Departments,"**

On the **Kindle** tab, select **> Manage Your Kindle** then

Sign In (to your account)

"Your Kindle Library" will be displayed.

Locate the book you want to turn in early and look to the right of the due date then click on

Actions... ▼

CAUTION! Do not **"Delete from Library"**

Select **"Return this Book"**

then select **Yes** (your e-book has been returned)

The e-book will still be displayed in

"Your Kindle Library"

To remove it, click on **Actions... ▼** then

"Delete from Library"
