a healer's daughter and a kite-flying, reluctant hero standing in its way. YAGN FIC YOLEN (G)

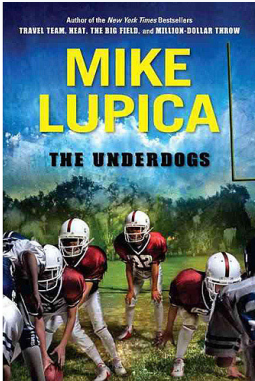

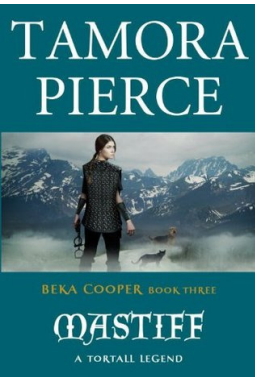

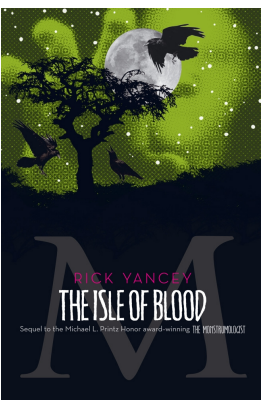

**White Crow** by Marcus Sedgwick. Sixteen-year-old Rebecca moves with her father from London to a small, seaside village, where she befriends another motherless girl and they

**Psycho Killer** by Cecily von Ziegesar. A reimagined version of the first Gossip girl novel. But here's where our dark tale takes a turn: Serena decides that the only way for her to make things right with Blair is to eliminate Nate. If that means killing him, well, c'est la vie. Her attempted murder doesn't go unnoticed by Blair, however, who isn't about to let Serena kill whoever she wants-not when there's Cyrus Rose and Chuck Bass and Titi Coates and everyone else who's ever irritated Blair to get rid of first.
